The Making Of The Mansions

This show stopping, jaw dropping show house has just opened it's doors to uproarious applause. Located within the beautiful 'golden triangle' in Ayr the location and site of 'The Mansions' alone, would make your heart skip a beat. **Jodi McLean reports on this award winning five star show house.**

WITH BOTH THE GOLF course and sea in view 'The Mansions', by Elphinstone, sits in probably one of the most covetable sites in Avr.

Literally a stones throw from the beach and next to Belleisle Golf Course, the position is absolutely idyllic.

Potential buyers from near and far had been waiting with baited breath to see the show house at this exciting new luxury development at Cunning Park, and the wait was certainly well worth it! 'Absolutely fabulous' would be a complete understatement in describing this magnificent show house, designed and furnished by XS Interiors of Bearsden, Glasgow.

According to top estate agents, Donald Ross, they have never had a more positive

response to a show house. 'We have had the most incredible feedback from viewers', commented Jacqueline Miller of Donald Ross. 'The interior design, furnishings and styling have really captivated the viewers and this, coupled with the location and build quality of The Mansions' has really put it on the map'. 'Everyone over the door has praised the show house and are genuinely bowled over with the interior' added Donald Ross partner, Steven Miller.

From Concept To Creation

When Sales Manager of Elphinstone, Pauline Coates, initially met up with Loraine Chassels of XS Interiors there was a special chemistry that happened. The architects plans were barely unfolded when the brainstorming between these two dynamic women began. Initial discussions on room themes, colours, furnishing styles and fabrics were all thrown in to the interior arena and Pauline and Loraine's first meeting together was the start of a partnership that would soon give birth to a super star show home at 'The Mansions'. After the initial meeting, first on the agenda

was for Loraine to provide story boards for Pauline to show the team at Elphinstone Loraine's vision for each room. Loraine designed every room and selected all the fabrics for the soft furnishings and wallpapers in addition to every item of furniture. Once the story boards were prepared Loraine brought







together examples of all the magnificent furniture she recommended for the show house and a Directors meeting was set up at Loraine and husband Carlo's design studio in Bearsden. 'I was really impressed with XS Interiors vision for 'The Mansions', commented Alasdair Carlyle, Director of

Elphinstone. 'The proposed interior design was excellent and her choice of furniture superb', he commented.

Pauline was delighted with the outcome of the meeting, 'With up to six bedrooms possible at the show house, I loved Loraine's take on a 'Juniors Room' as one of them, and thought the 'Relax and Renew Spa Room' was a brilliant and novel concept!', she enthused. 'I always wanted an organic feel to the decor, explained Pauline,' and the bespoke fabric sofas and chairs Loraine designed, using No No fabrics, in the drawing and dining rooms along with their coordinating pelmets and feature cushions were brilliant', she added. It seems Loraine worked through this brief from Pauline and even translated the organic ethos through to the Family room, with it's organic feature lighting and ribbed curtain fabric, from award winning Voyage Decoration. The striking textured feature chair and console table in the family room were handmade from natural water hyacinth, by Hyacinth Design. Even the feature peacock headboard and curtains in the Master Suite, again featuring Voyage fabric, were made of organic silk.

From this first meeting, showing the concept for the complete property, Loraine certainly had her work cut out, and this was just the beginning.

Born to Shine

The grand hall, on two levels, is the perfect entry to 'The Mansions'. XS used amethyst alcantara suede quirky chairs for a contemporary edge and tied this colour

way in with a huge oversized lily display in the same amethyst tone in a le touquet Italian vase, mounted on a mirrored plinth. Adding more glamour in the lower hall, a mirror topped charcoal Zen console table rubs shoulders with magnificent imported mirrors from Belgium. Simply stunning hand made lighting, from New Orleans, sit atop the console and crown the landing in the form of a grand chandelier. The upper hall echoes the mirrored appeal with a cut mirrored mosaic mirror and console table adorned with blown glass candle ball holders to complete the

look.

'The Mansions' abounds in space and this is particularly evident on the ground floor where the stunning lounge opens up into the formal dining room through double glass doors, creating a vast space. The ebony and ivory colour way is the height of sophistication. Vanilla cut velvet pelmets coordinate perfectly with the bespoke sofas and Gleneagles tub chair, designed by XS Interiors. A baby grand piano, in polished black lacquer, graces the huge bay window

overlooking the lawns of 'The Mansions'. The magnificent Blairquhan fireplace in the drawing room was manufactured and installed by Athena in Kilmaurs. Made of Verona natural limestone it features scone brick and a large Nexus basket and logs- a perfect match for the interior. It gives a cosy heart to the home, while the original oil painting, supplied from Loraine and Carlo's private studio at XS Interiors, by artist Gerard Burns adds a real wow. Interesting sculptures adom New York style pedestals and sit aside unusual acrylic

block art in boutique hotel style frames. The round glass dining table with coordinate feature mirror creates a statement and hints at wonderful dinner parties.

The family room is flooded with light and with French doors that lead on to the perfectly landscaped grounds, it is a room for all seasons. Incredible hand woven feature lighting creates an artistic look and fuse perfectly with the water hyacinth woven console table and wenge backed hyacinth chair. The textured fabric sofa is imported from Spain while the coffee table and entertainment unit, clad in chocolate leather, and are from Italy.


The dining kitchen, with direct access out to the garden, is a masterpiece in interior design. The contemporary layout and styling with Poggenpohl kitchen furniture, by award winning Kitchens International, features a creative mix of blossom white and teak decor lava and the centre island with it's zodiac alabaster work surface is the ultimate in luxury. Add this to any domestic goddess's wish list and hey presto the top of the range Miele appliances abound. From the latest ovens, combi -microwave, steam oven, and warming drawer to the state of the art wine cooler and ever invaluable coffee machine, nothing is missing. Even the laundry utility room has the highly desirable Miele washer and driers in situ. The dining area sports a beautiful Italian glass dining table and sideboard to match with a sensational sculptured art plaque above, adorned with pewter roses.

Sleeping beauty could not want for a better boudoir as seen in this striking and original Master Bedroom suite. Enchanting peacock adorned silk fabric is used within the window treatments and on the hand made headboard. Lime green and teal colours are juxtaposed throughout in the soft furnishings and ornamentation. A waxed feather trimmed cushion and Austin bronze peacock filigree sculpture, on the grand chest, reiterate the thematic of this room. The attention to detail





is incredible. Cream solid wood furniture add to the rich appearance of the bedroom.

The Principal Guest Bedroom is a latte layered inspiration and from the bespoke wallboard to the mirrored furniture the feeling is opulent. Clarity in colours of oyster, latte, cream and charcoal echo the drawing and dining room downstairs and make for a perfect guest retreat.

The Jaipur Guest bedroom boasts a hand crafted and painted bergere wood bed and matching finial cabinets, inspired from the days of the Raj, while a jewel encrusted Gustav Klimt canvass art embraces the viewers as does the mother and child oversized floor sculpture from Texas and the gold LOVE sign on the hand painted wood console. This room gives you a hug.

Throughout the fabulous bedrooms XS

have used lovely full bedspreads and teamed them with American coordinate large cosy stuffed pillow shams and a multitude of decor cushions and layering throws, by Samuel Homes the soft furnishing specialists Loraine loves.

The Relax and Renew Spa Room has great personality and so fresh in both style and concept. The feature sea shell and stone photographic art XS have used give 'The Mansions' a beachy feel (well the beach is just a minute away, after all), and the imported driftwood lamps from Paris add to the feeling of nature. The trickle of the pebble water fountain beckons you to the leather massage bed. What a great idea for a spare bedroom!


